Dear Ms. Boyer-Vine, Mr. Alvarez, and Mr. Wilson:

Below is the Judicial Council report required by Government Code section 69958 on the purchasing or leasing of electronic recording equipment during the period of January 1 through June 30, 2018.

As required by statute, for each purchase or lease of equipment, the report specifies the name of the court, the types of proceedings for which the equipment will be used, the cost of the equipment, and the types of equipment purchased or leased.

Government Code section 69957 requires the courts to obtain advanced approval from the Judicial Council before purchasing or leasing any electronic recording technology or equipment. manner and for the purposes authorized under that section. All 58 superior courts were surveyed regarding their purchase or lease of equipment to ensure that all purchases or leases were made with the required authorization. During the January 1, 2018, through June 30, 2018 reporting period, two courts purchased electronic equipment or related items for use in court proceedings.

The Superior Court of Mendocino County spent \$21,801 to purchase electronic and recording equipment and software. This new equipment and software is used for official court records. An itemized list of the purchases can be found in Attachment A.

The Superior Court of Santa Barbara County spent \$21,890 to upgrade existing For The Record (FTR) Gold Systems in 22 courtrooms. An itemized list of the purchases can be found in Attachment B.

The total amount spent by the two courts on the purchase of electronic recording equipment during the reporting period was \$43,691.
