Revenue Distribution Session B

The information in this handout will be used to perform distributions for five case studies. Case information will be gathered real-time and entered on the respective worksheet, as we review the calculations and distribution process.

Step 1: Gather information about the citation (from the case management system/case file):

- Violation type (infraction or misdemeanor)
- Violation date and conviction date
- Disposition on each count (e.g., conviction, traffic school)
- Prior violations
- Arresting agency:
 - ✓ If applicable, determine city/county percentage split, under [Penal Code 1463.002](#)
- Base fine amount \$___:
 - ✓ Refer to the 2023 Uniform Bail & Penalty Schedules [UB&PS](#)
- Code section(s) violated
 - ✓ Research statute in the *California Legislative Information* [Leg. Info](#) website.
 - ✓ Search authorized distributions in the State Controller's Office [Guidelines](#) (Rev. 33).

Step 2. Obtain current authorized amount by county BOS resolutions for applicable local penalties.

- ✓ Government Code 76100 – LCCF: \$___
- ✓ Government Code 76101 – LCJF: \$___
- ✓ Government Code 76104 – EMS: \$___
- ✓ Government Code 76104.5 – DNA ID: \$___
- ✓ Government Code 76102 – Auto Fingerprint: \$___
- ✓ Government Code 76000.5 EMS Additional Penalty: \$___

Step 3: Determine other case and/or court specific factors and obtain current authorized amount. Confirm local and case specific fee amounts as they can and do vary from county to county. As an example, these base fine reductions specific to a DUI case:

- ✓ Penal Code section 1463.14(a) – DUI Lab Special Account (\$50.00)
- ✓ Penal Code section 1463.16 - DUI Program Special Account (BOS: \$50.00)
- ✓ Penal Code section 1463.18 - DUI Indemnity Allocation (\$20.00)

Case Study #1. Scenario 2: "Prior" added *only* to moving violations

VII. Prior Convictions

A. The base fine for one Vehicle Code moving violation that is assessed "points" on a current arrest or citation **may be** enhanced by \$10 for each "prior" conviction within 36 months of the new alleged offense. For calculating the enhancement, both the current and "prior" offense must be a moving violation for which a "point" has been assigned per Vehicle Code section 12810 or 12810.2. A confidential conviction after completion of traffic violator school is not assigned a point or counted as a prior offense for purposes of enhancing the fine of a subsequent offense. Regardless of the number of moving violation convictions on a citation, only one "prior" per citation shall be counted in determining the enhancement on the current offense.

Base fine is unchanged from 2022.

However, total has been reduced by \$4 due to the elimination of EMAT.

Moving violations which earn 1 or more DMV "points" qualify as a prior and increase the base fine for subsequent violations.



The bail amounts in UB&PS calculation is based on maximum county (\$7/10) and EMS additional penalty (\$2/10). Subtotal and Total Amount in UB&PS will reconcile to worksheet totals **if** the local penalties are assessed at maximum amount.
