Order: (dispositive)

On the court's own motion, the order in the above-captioned matter, dated July 31, 2014, is vacated, and the following order is entered:

The court orders that DEBORAH PAULINE GUTIERREZ, State Bar Number 240383, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and she is placed on probation for two years subject to the following conditions:

1. DEBORAH PAULINE GUTIERREZ is suspended from the practice of law for the first 30 days of probation;
2. DEBORAH PAULINE GUTIERREZ must comply with the conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on March 27, 2014, except for condition F(2). Gutierrez need not comply with condition F(2), which appears on page 6 of the stipulation, under the heading "Other Conditions Negotiated by the Parties."
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if DEBORAH PAULINE GUTIERREZ has complied with all conditions of probation other than condition F(2), the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

DEBORAH PAULINE GUTIERREZ must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment. One half of the costs must be paid with her membership fees for each of the years 2015 and 2016. If DEBORAH PAULINE GUTIERREZ fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

The motion, filed October 17, 2014, for an order relieving DEBORAH PAULINE GUTIERREZ of the requirements of California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, is denied as moot.
