FY24-25 Proposal Snapshot

- 140 local court project proposals
- From 40 trial courts and 1 appellate court
- Totaling over \$50m in requested funding

Workstream Review

- Reviewed all proposals (excluding budgets)
- Sought more information from courts when lacking/needed
- Flagged court projects that:
 - Did not meet project proposal requirements (next slide)
 - Could potentially be funded through other programs (alternate funding)
 - Conflict with branch standards/initiatives
- Reviewed recommendations for consistency amongst decisions
- Finalized proposed project approval recommendations (attached)

Court Project Requirements

- Benefit the public
- Comply with branchwide policies and standards
- Be vetted and approved by the Technology Committee
- Fall within at least one of the approved program categories
- Initiate project activities immediately after approved (July 2024)
- Show demonstrable progress by end of 2024
- Expend or encumber funds by end of the fiscal year (June 30, 2025)
- Project completion by end of the third fiscal year (June 30, 2027)
- Report quarterly on measurable, successful outcomes
