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PENAL CODE - PEN
PART 2. OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE [681 - 1620] (Part 2 enacted 1872.)
TITLE 11. PROCEEDINGS IN MISDEMEANOR AND INFRACTION CASES AND APPEALS FROM SUCH CASES [1427 - 1471] (Heading of Title 11 amended by Stats. 1998, Ch. 931, Sec. 407.)

CHAPTER 1. Proceedings in Misdemeanor and Infraction Cases [1427 - 1465.9] (Heading of Chapter 1 amended by Stats. 1998, Ch. 931, Sec. 408.)

1463.001. Except as otherwise provided in this section, all fines and forfeitures imposed and collected for crimes other than parking offenses resulting from a filing in a court, including civil assessments imposed under Section 1214.1, shall as soon as practicable after receipt thereof, be deposited with the county treasurer, and each month the total fines and forfeitures which have accumulated within the past month shall be distributed, as follows:

(a) The state penalties, county penalties, special penalties, service charges, penalty allocations, and civil assessments imposed under Section 1214.1, shall be transferred to the proper funds as required by law.

(b) The base fines shall be distributed, as follows:

(1) Any base fines which are subject to specific distribution under any other section shall be distributed to the specified funds of the state or local agency.

(2) Base fines resulting from county arrest not included in paragraph (1), shall be transferred into the proper funds of the county.

(3) Base fines resulting from city arrests not included in paragraph (1), an amount equal to the applicable county percentages set forth in Section 1463.002, as modified by Section 1463.28, shall be transferred into the proper funds of the county. Until July 1, 1998, the remainder of base fines resulting from city arrests shall be divided between each city and county, with 50 percent deposited to the county's general fund, and 50 percent deposited to the treasury of the appropriate city, and thereafter the remainder of base fines resulting from city arrests shall be deposited to the treasury of the appropriate city.

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Case Study #1. Scenario 2: "Prior" added *only* to moving violations

VII. Prior Convictions

A. The base fine for one Vehicle Code moving violation that is assessed "points" on a current arrest or citation **may be** enhanced by \$10 for each "prior" conviction within 36 months of the new alleged offense. For calculating the enhancement, both the current and "prior" offense must be a moving violation for which a "point" has been assigned per Vehicle Code section 12810 or 12810.2. A confidential conviction after completion of traffic violator school is not assigned a point or counted as a prior offense for purposes of enhancing the fine of a subsequent offense. Regardless of the number of moving violation convictions on a citation, only one "prior" per citation shall be counted in determining the enhancement on the current offense.

Top-Down Distributions

Method 1: prorate “soft” distribution components ONLY.

The case information, base fine, local penalties, and standard and court fees and assessments is prefilled. With this information already input, we can see that the standard total fine is \$234.

- Now, let’s assume that based on an ability to pay determination, the judge orders a total fine amount of \$117. Let’s see what the top-down distribution will be for a \$117 total fine.
- Enter the total fine ordered in the **yellow highlighted cell**.
- Let’s look at the last column within the Top-Down section.

Note that the fixed amounts are whole. That means that after distributing the total fine to these fixed amounts, the remainder is prorated among the remaining fines and penalties. The calculation starts with the total fine, subtracts the fixed amounts, and then uses the remainder as the base for prorating the remainder to the fines, penalties, and state surcharge.

Method 2: Prorate ALL distribution components.

- Input the same \$117---total reduced fine ordered by a judge.
- The fixed amounts from the standard distribution are no longer whole. That means that these amounts are also prorated along with the non-fixed fines and penalties. *The math involves using the total fine as the base for prorating the total fine to all the components of the total fine.*
- Note: This is the method that may be applied to ATP cases—
