

Notice of Action by E-mail Between Meetings for Judicial Council Technology Committee

In accordance with California Rules of Court, rule 10.75(o)(1)(B), public notice is hereby given that the Technology Committee proposes to act by email between meetings on **Wednesday**, **May 29 at 12 noon**. The Chair has concluded that prompt action is needed.

Background

At their April 15 open meeting, the Technology Committee voted to approve the distribution of approximately \$1.7 million in leftover funding from the IT Modernization Program funding from fiscal year (FY) 2023-24 to new courthouses to accommodate the hybrid courtroom legislative requirements (please see minutes and materials beginning on page four). However, the reappropriation of Assembly Bill 716 funding to encompass new courthouse projects now renders this allocation unnecessary. Approximately \$700,000 of this leftover funding has been absorbed by previously approved branchwide programs, and the committee is being asked to consider the distribution of the remainder of the IT Modernization Program funds, approximately \$1 million, to the Judicial Branch Networking Solutions (JBNS) program. This program provides network maintenance and operations support for the Judicial Council and Superior Courts.

Proposed Action

The committee will consider a proposal to allocate the remaining FY 2023-24 IT Modernization Program funding, approximately \$1 million, to the Judicial Branch Networking Solutions program (JBNS).

Written Comment
