The Judicial Council has submitted a report to the Legislature in accordance with Penal Code section 1172.2.

The following summary of the report is provided under the requirements of Government Code section 9795.

In 2023, 89 cases were referred to a court for recall and resentencing in instances in which an incarcerated person has a serious illness with an end-of-life trajectory or is medically incapacitated. The report includes demographics and referral criteria data of the cases referred, and the court's decision.

January 1, 2024

Penal Code section <u>1172.2</u> authorizes the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation to recommend recall and resentence when an incarcerated person has a serious illness with an end-of-life trajectory or is medically incapacitated. This report fulfills the Judicial Council's mandate to release an annual report that includes demographics and criteria of referral. Note: this report does not include cases which were not referred to the court due to lack of postrelease plans.
