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3. collections personnel and reported as gross court collections distributions. The FTB bills us quarterly for

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4. services and it is impossible to apply its charges to civil assessment payments.

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5. Our CMS reports only the net receipts and distributions of GC Services, a third party collector. CG Services fees vary

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6. from 20-25% depending on age of receivable.

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7. This being the case, what is reported in Section 5 is the gross amount received by the court (gross court collections,

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8. gross FTB collections & net GC Services collections) and the amount retained by the court pursuant to PC 1463.007.

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
