

In 2023, California had more than 10,000 homeless veterans, with 70% living unsheltered. The state had the highest number of homeless veterans in the country, both overall and within the unsheltered subgroup. California accounted for nearly 30% of the nation's total homeless veteran population and 50% of unsheltered homeless veterans nationwide.

Drop in homeless veteran POPULATION IN THE LAST DECADE

From 2013 to 2023, California saw a nearly 20% decrease in its homeless veteran population, while the national decline was 36%. During the same period, California's unsheltered homeless veteran population dropped by 7%, compared to a 25% decline nationwide.
