Los Angeles Spring Street Courtrooms Relocation FY 2026-27 Budget Change Concept

Background

- U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) Building at 312 N. Spring Street.
- Constructed circa 1940.
- Approximately 201,167 SF with 24 civil courtrooms.
- Lease ends on 12/31/2028.

Additional Information

- Lease renegotiation started in 2024.
- Communication with GSA.
- Personnel changes within GSA in March 2025.
- GSA informed the Judicial Council of no lease renewal.
- GSA indicated to divest property.

Potential Options

- 1. Relocate 24 courtrooms to new leased space.
- 2. Relocate 24 courtrooms to existing Los Angeles courthouses.
- 3. Combination of 1 and 2 above.

Option 1 — Relocation to Leased Space

- Information from Los Angeles Long-Range Plan:
 - Construction Courtrooms + Office Space ~\$141M
 - Monthly Rent ~\$2.3M
 - Annual Rent ~ \$27.6M
 - Current Annual Rent ~\$3.8M

Option 2 - Relocation into Existing Space

Identify potential Los Angeles courthouses.

Courtrooms that need renovation, buildout, or refresh.

Conduct analysis to identify scope, budget, and schedule.

Implementation Steps

- Initial Meeting with Los Angeles Court 3/14/2025
- Relocation Plan from Los Angeles Court 4/7/2025
- Scope Development and Estimating 4/17/2025
- Budget Change Concept for TCFMAC Review 4/24/2025

Relocation Scope and Cost

- Determined need to move 23 civil courtrooms.
- Relocation to 10 different existing Los Angeles Court facilities:
 - Building out 6 courtrooms Chatsworth Courthouse.
 - Refreshing 17 courtrooms Nine courthouses.
- Cost is estimated at \$42.4M one-time in FY 2026–27.

Project Schedule

- BCP Funding July 2026.
- Design Complete June 2027.
- Construction & Move-in October 2028.

Requested Action

Recommend the draft relocation Budget Change Concept is approved for consideration by the Judicial Branch Budget Committee and Judicial Council.
