



- 1           (7) If a warrant was presented, the type of warrant; and  
2           (8) Any other information, as determined by the Administrative Director,  
3           necessary to evaluate the impact of civil arrests in court facilities.

5   **(c) Personal identifying information of targeted individual**

7           Information reported under (b) must not include the identity, or other personal  
8           identifying information, of any individual who was a target for civil arrest.
