
2026 Annual Agenda: Oversight Committee Project Prioritization

Juvenile Behavioral Health Judicial Resource Guide (New)

Develop a user-friendly guide for judges and court professionals working in juvenile collaborative courts that educates them about the various types of mental health therapies and services and where in their community those resources would be available for youth. The objective of the project is to help courts working with youth and families better serve those populations.

This project will begin January 2026 and is anticipated to be completed by December 31, 2026

Update Standards of Judicial Administration (Continuing)

Update standard 4.10 of the Standards of Judicial Administration (Guidelines for diversion drug court programs), to fulfill the requirements of Senate Bill 910. SB 910 requires the Judicial Council to amend Standards of Judicial Administration to reflect state and nationally recognized best practices and guidelines for adult collaborative treatment court programs.

Anticipate circulating for comment in winter 2025, for an effective date of July 1, 2026
