Item 1

Appellate Procedure: Advisement of appellate rights in juvenile cases (Action Required)

Consider whether to recommend amending the rule regarding advisement of the right of review in juvenile cases to remove the requirement that parents be present at the hearing to receive advisement of their appellate rights.

Item 2

Appellate Procedure: Notice of appeal and the record in civil commitment cases (Action Required)

Consider whether to recommend a rule setting forth the contents of the normal record on appeal and a form notice of appeal for civil commitment cases.

Item 3

Appellate Procedure: Access to juvenile case files in appellate court proceedings (Action Required)

Consider whether to recommend rules to implement AB 1617 regarding access to juvenile court records in appellate proceedings.

Item 4

CEQA: New Fees for Expedited Review (Action Required)

Consider whether to recommend that proposed new and amended rules circulate for public comment.

Item 5

Appellate Procedure: Word limit for petitions for rehearing in unlimited civil cases (Action Required)

Consider whether to recommend a rule to limit the word count of petitions for rehearing in unlimited civil cases.
