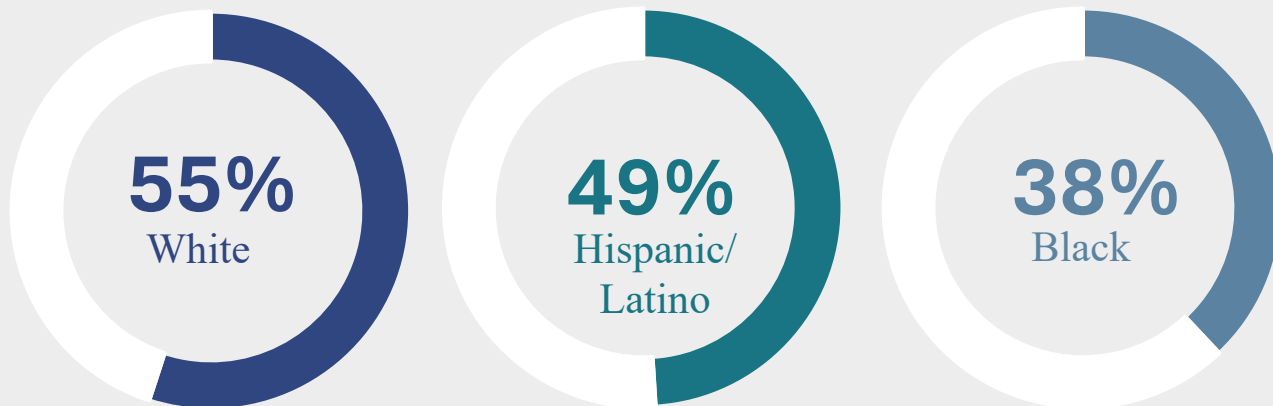

Priority 2: Equity Assessment Tool



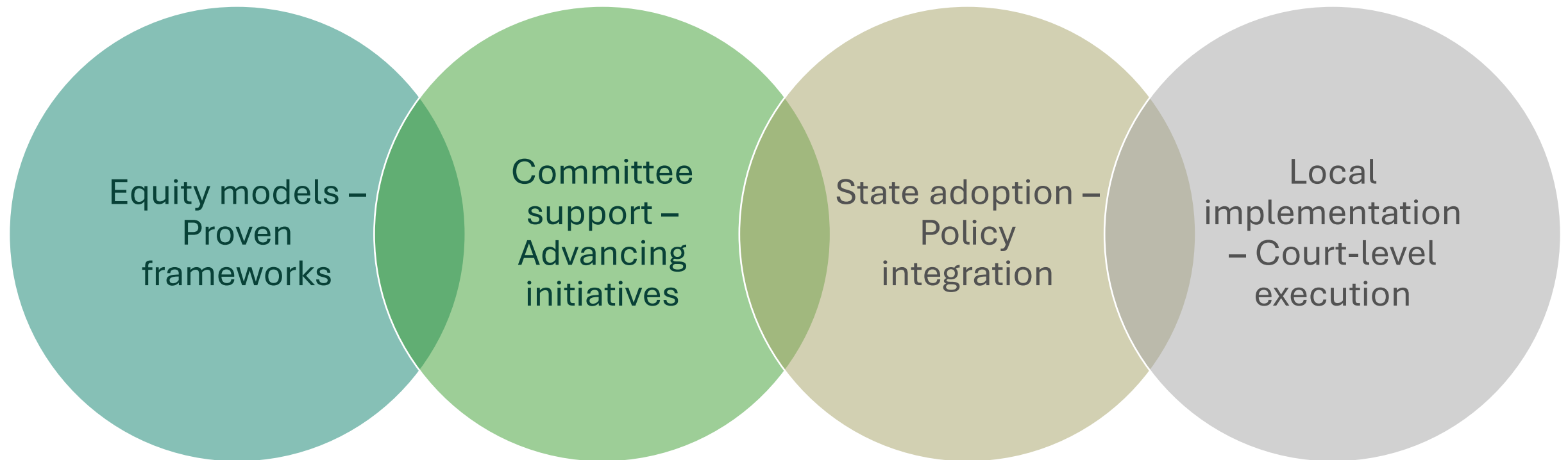
Available assessment tool
