The chair of the Executive and Planning Committee having concluded that prompt action is needed, public notice is hereby given that the Executive and Planning Committee proposes to act by email between meetings starting at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 24, 2022, in accordance with the California Rules of Court, rule 10.75(o)(1)(B). Proposed Action

Review a recommendation from Office of Court Research staff to confirm a request by the Superior Court of Sacramento County for a fractional increase in the workload of a part-time subordinate judicial officer position to a 1.0 full-time equivalency due to operational needs of the court and because of the court's inability to attract qualified candidates to fill a part-time position.

Written Comment
