##### Item 1

##### Family Law: Assisted Reproduction Parentage Rules and Forms

The committee will consider a proposal for a new set of statewide forms specific to assisted reproduction parentage actions and proceedings under Family Code sections 7613, 7630, and 7960–7962.

##### Item 2

##### Family and Juvenile Law - Recognition and Enforcement of Tribal Court Child Custody Orders

The committee will consider a proposal that clarifies that the requirement to recognize and enforce child custody orders under the provisions of the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act (Family Code sections 3400–3465) apply to custody orders issued by a tribal court.

##### Item 3

##### Juvenile Law: Harm of Removal

The committee will consider a proposal to implement SB 578, which created new factors to be considered by the juvenile court at a detention hearing, such as the impact on the child when being separated from their parent or guardian at a detention hearing, and new reporting requirements for the placing agency.
