Juvenile Law: Harm of Removal

The committee will continue discussion of a proposal to implement SB 578, which created new factors to be considered by the juvenile court at a detention hearing, such as the impact on the child when being separated from their parent or guardian at a detention hearing, and new reporting requirements for the placing agency.

Family Law: Adoption Forms Revision

The committee will consider revisions to adoption forms to adhere to requirements for consents, relinquishments, termination of parental rights or freedom from parental custody and control for all statutorily defined persons with parental rights as well as adopt a new Stepparent Adoption Request form.
