##### Juvenile Law: Revisions to CR-110/JV-790 and CR-112/JV-792

The committee will review a proposal to revise two restitution forms used in juvenile proceedings to implement Assembly Bill 2286 (Stats. 2024, ch. 805)

##### Item 2

##### Family Law: Joint Petition for Dissolution or Legal Separation

The committee will consider a proposal to amend four rules of court, adopt four forms, and approve an information sheet to implement Senate Bill 1427 (Stats. 2024, ch. 190). Effective January 1, 2026, SB 1427 authorizes parties who do not qualify to use the current summary dissolution process to file a joint summons and a joint petition to ask the court for a dissolution of the marriage or domestic partnership or legal separation. The legislation requires the Judicial Council to adopt or amend any rules or forms necessary for implementation.

##### Item 3

##### Juvenile Law: Revision to JC-915-INFO

The committee will review a proposal to revise the *Information on Filing a Petition to Terminate Juvenile Sex Offender Registration* (form JV-915-INFO) to remove language inapplicable in juvenile cases.
