Protective Orders: Changes to Domestic Violence and Juvenile Forms to Implement AB 2759

Family Law: Joint Petition for Dissolution or Legal Separation

The committee will review the public comments received, suggested revisions, responses to public comment, and a draft Judicial Council report that recommends amending four rules of court, adopting three forms, and approving an information sheet to implement Senate Bill 1427 (Stats. 2024, ch. 190).

Item 3

Family Law and Protective Orders: Implementation of SB 599 and AB 3072

The committee will review the public comments received, suggested revisions, responses to public comment, and a draft Judicial Council report to implement SB 599 (Stats. 2023, ch. 493) and AB 3072 (Stats. 2024, ch. 317). The committee will discuss two new forms (one for the DV series and one for the FL series) and a rule of court; new INFO forms on child custody and visitation; a standard of judicial administration; and proposed revisions to existing DV and FL forms.
