Item 1

Family Law: Revise Summons Forms to Implement AB 1297

(Presenter: Gabrielle Selden, Attorney, Center for Families, Children, & the Courts) The committee will review a proposal to revise four family law summons forms to implement Assembly Bill 1297, effective January 1, 2027, by including that parties are prohibited from allowing a plan to lapse for nonpayment of premiums or failing to renew insurance. The proposal will also include reformatting the summonses and using plain language to make the forms easier to read and understand.

Item 2

Juvenile Law: Revise Court Order Forms JV-180 and JV-183 and Amend Rule 5.570 Regarding Improperly Filed Petitions Requests for Sibling Visitation

(Presenter: Lizette Perez, Attorney, Center for Families, Children, & the Courts) The committee will review a proposal to (1) revise form JV-180, JV-183 and rule 5.570 as they relate to improperly filed petitions, (2) consider whether to revoke form JV-740 and amend rule 5.570(b) to require the use of form JV-180 for petitions filed under section 778, and (3) amend rule 5.570 to add a balancing test when determining sibling visitation in the context of a nondependent sibling.
