Item 1

Family Law: Rule 5.275 Amendments – Child Support Calculator Certification

(Presenter: Marina Soto, Attorney, Center for Families, Children, & the Courts)

The committee will review a proposal to invite public comment on amendments to rule 5.275, previously approved without comment due to urgent circumstances related to the recertification process for the state calculator used by the Department of Child Support Services. The committee will also consider additional amendments related to calculator certification that were deferred in December 2025.

Item 2

Juvenile Law: Transfer of Nonminor Dependents under AB 890

(Presenter: Kerry Doyle, Center for Families, Children, & the Courts)

The committee will review proposed changes to amend rule 5.613 and revise forms JV-462, JV-548 (tentative), and JV-552 to implement AB 890, which allows nonminor dependents to request a transfer of jurisdiction to a county with which they have significant connections.

Item 3

Juvenile Law: Incarcerated parents under AB 651

(Presenter: Sarah Saria, Center for Families, Children, & the Courts)

The committee will review proposed amendments to rules 5.530 and 5.900 and revisions to forms JV-450 and JV-451 to align with AB 651, which updates procedures for prisoner appearances in hearings affecting parental rights.
