Item 1

Juvenile Law: Extension of firearm prohibition under AB 383

(Presenter: Kristen Schmit, Attorney, Center for Families, Children, & the Courts)

The committee will review a proposal to make form CR-210 a joint juvenile form for minors convicted of certain offenses until the age of 25 or 30. This proposal will also be reviewed by the Criminal Law Advisory Committee.

Item 2

Juvenile Law: Probation and duration of hearings under AB 1376

(Presenter: Kerry Doyle, Attorney, Center for Families, Children, & the Courts)

The committee will review proposed rule and form changes to implement AB 1376, which establishes a rebuttable presumption limiting probation to 12 months and requires regular review hearings if probation is extended.

Item 3

Juvenile Law: Transfer of Nonminor Dependents under AB 890

(Presenter: Kerry Doyle, Attorney, Center for Families, Children, & the Courts)

The committee will review proposed changes to amend rule 5.613 and revise forms JV-462, JV-548 (tentative), and JV-552 to implement AB 890, which allows nonminor dependents to request a transfer of jurisdiction to a county with which they have significant connections.

Item 4

AB 1974: Amending rules 5.215 and 5.230

(Presenter: Gabrielle Selden, Attorney, Center for Families, Children, & the Courts)

The committee will revisit and discuss proposed amendments to rules 5.215 and 5.230 to implement Assembly Bill 1974 (Stats. 2024, ch 303), effective January 1, 2027.
