Family Law: Quadrennial review of statewide uniform child support guideline (Action Required)

California Family Code section 4054 and 45 Code of Federal Regulations section 302.56 require the Judicial Council of California to conduct a comprehensive review of the statewide uniform child support guideline at least every four years. The committee will receive a presentation on the draft 2025 guideline review report, engage in discussion of the report's findings and conclusions, and consider whether to recommend approval of the report for submission to the Legislature.
