Family Law: Implement Assembly Bill 1267 Prohibiting Marriage of Minors (Action Required)

The committee will review a special cycle report to revoke one rule of court and repeal three forms to implement Assembly Bill 1267. Effective January 1, 2027 (pending approval by the Governor), AB 1267 prohibits persons under 18 years old from being issued a marriage license or establishing a domestic partnership, which will require the Judicial Council to take action to avoid continued use of obsolete rules, forms, and procedures by the effective date of the legislation.
