Notice of Action by E-mail Between Meetings for Information Technology Advisory Committee

The Chair of the Information Technology Advisory Committee having concluded that prompt action is needed, public notice is hereby given that the Information Technology Advisory Committee proposes to act by email between meetings on Monday, May 5 at 9 am in accordance with California Rules of Court, rule 10.75(o)(1)(B). A copy of the proposed action is available on the advisory body web page on the California Courts website listed above.

Background

During the April 28 ITAC meeting, the committee approved the workstream's project recommendations, excluding those involving artificial intelligence (AI). To ensure that all remaining proposals with a generative AI component would comply with the proposed rule of court and standard of judicial administration being developed by the Judicial Council's AI Task Force, the committee deferred consideration of AI-related proposals pending further evaluation. Courts with identified projects were asked to confirm whether their proposals involved the use of generative AI and, if so, whether they would adhere to the forthcoming policy. Based on the responses received and subsequent project review, the recommendations were updated by the ITAC chair and workstream leads.

Additionally, proposals from the Superior Court of Santa Clara County were incorporated into the project list along with recommendations, per the ITAC chair and workstream lead review. These proposals were not initially captured due to a technical issue encountered during the application submission process.

Proposed Action

The committee will consider a proposal to approve the workstream's remaining IT Modernization project recommendations for FY 2025-26, as identified in the materials for this action.
