Notice of Action by Email Between Meetings for Information Technology Advisory Committee

The chair of the Information Technology Advisory Committee having concluded that prompt action is needed, public notice is hereby given that the Information Technology Advisory Committee (ITAC) proposes to act by email between meetings on April 24, 2026, in accordance with rule 10.75(o)(1)(B) of the California Rules of Court. A copy of the proposed action is available on the advisory body web page on the California courts website listed above.

Background

During the April 15, 2026, meeting, ITAC heard a request to approve the proposed grant awards for the Language Access Signage and Technology Grant Program, Cycle 8, for fiscal year (FY) 2026–27 to send to the Judicial Council Technology Committee. The program provides annual funding to support multilingual signage, wayfinding improvements, interpreter equipment, and other technology solutions that enhance access for limited-English-proficient, deaf, or hard-of-hearing court users. During the discussion, a member identified the absence of a court’s application from the materials presented. Because of this omission, no action was taken at the meeting. The proposal has since been revised to include the additional court application.

Proposed Action

ITAC will consider approving the revised proposed grant awards for the Language Access Signage and Technology Grant Program, Cycle 8 for FY 2026–27 to send to the Technology Committee, as described in the materials for this action.
