Keep it simple – support a streamlined and efficient process

Court Project Requirements **for Courts**

- Benefit the public
- Comply with branchwide policies and standards
- Obtain Technology Committee approval
- Align with approved program categories
- Key dates
 - Show demonstrable progress by end of the calendar year (6 months)
 - Spend or encumber funds by end of first fiscal year
 - Complete project by end of third fiscal year
- Report bi-annually on measurable, successful outcomes

Electronic Records Management	27	20
