### **Proposed Action**

The committee will consider whether to approve the recommended allocations for the Jury Management System Grant program for Fiscal Year 2019 – 2020. The budget for the Jury System Grant Program is funded by royalties from selling jury instructions which are deposited in the Trial Court Improvement and Modernization Fund. These funds can only be used for jury-related projects. Funding allocations are proposed according to the objectives of the program, prioritization categories, funding metrics, and other considerations.
