
RFA Summary

- Expanded Definition of Trial Court Digital Services

Provide digital services for the virtual and physical courthouse that would include projects such as, but not limited to, improved websites, branchwide online programs, courtroom technology for public access, jury selection, electronic recording (where permitted by law), and digital calendars/communications.

- 23 Trial Court Digital Services

- Websites
- Mobile Apps
- Courtroom Technology-Audio and Video solutions
- Electronic Recording
- Electronic Signage




Trial Court Success

- 34 Courts provided by November 18
 - Compliant/within Scope of Program Projects
 - Provided high-level, yet detailed budgets
 - Provided detailed implementation plans
- 17 Courts needed follow-up for additional information
