In accordance with California Rules of Court, rule 10.75(o)(1)(B), public notice is hereby given that the Language Access Plan Implementation Task Force (LAPITF) proposes to act by e-mail between meetings on Thursday, November 2, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. to approve submission of a proposal to the Policy, Coordination and Liaison Committee (PCLC). The proposal recommends that the Judicial Council sponsor legislation to amend Government Code section 68560.5(a) and Code of Civil Procedure section 116.550 regarding the provision of court interpreter in small claims matters. The proposed action is by e-mail because prompt action is required. The deadline to submit materials to Governmental Affairs staff for the November 16, 2017 PCLC meeting is Monday, November 6, 2017.
