I am pleased to inform you that the Judicial Council is in support of AB 1787, which would require that an emergency protective order (EPO) be issued by a judicial officer pursuant to a specific request from law enforcement, because it ensures the proper alignment of judicial and executive functions, and protects the exclusive authority of the court to issue protective orders. This view of the proper allocation of responsibilities for obtaining and issuing EPOs is consistent with the statutory scheme in place for law enforcement to obtain an EPO, which specifically requires that the presiding judge of each superior court designate at least one judicial officer to be available to issue these orders whether or not court is in session. Thus the council supports AB 1787 because it is consistent with the intent of the existing statute, promotes the council's strategic goal of enhancing judicial independence, and preserves the appropriate role of the court in issuing protective orders.
