**FAMILY AND JUVENILE LAW**

**Item 01**

**Family Law: Certification and Use of Computer Software Used to Assist in Determining Support**

The committee reviewed a recommendation from the Family and Juvenile Law Advisory Committee that the Judicial Council, effective December 13, 2025, and January 1, 2026, amend rule 5.275 of the California Rules of Court. Rule 5.275 provides standards for computer software that assist in determining child and spousal support.

***Action: The committee, by majority vote, approved the recommendation from the Family and Juvenile Law Advisory Committee, which is to go to the Judicial Council for action at the December council meeting.***
