SCIP Funding and Purpose

- Authorized by the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act of 2022
- Funded through US DOJ, BJA, Byrne/JAG to California Board of State and Community Corrections
- Use of funds includes collaborative courts and related “initiatives that work to keep guns out of the hands of those who pose a threat to themselves or others”

JCC RFPs

- ✓ Summer 2024 - \$15m available
 - Sacramento, San Francisco, San Joaquin, Santa Clara, Solano, Sonoma awarded approximately \$11m
- ✓ Spring 2025 - \$13m available
- ✓ Spring 2026 – Total award amount TBD
- ✓ Spring 2027 - Total award amount TBD

- Focusing on MH Diversion and Veteran Treatment Court Programs
- Participant data reporting to JCC for program evaluation
- Documenting gun relinquishment procedures for prohibited program participants
