To: Workload Assessment Advisory Committee:

As the Workload Assessment Advisory Committee (WAAC) continues to review the 2018 Judicial Workload Study Updated Caseweights, I respectfully submit three brief comments for your consideration:

- 1. I commend the Judicial Council and WAAC for continuously and transparently reviewing and updating the mathematical formula that assesses judicial need as well as prioritization of judgeships.
- 2. I commend the Judicial Council and WAAC for amending policy to recognize that the workload need of a smaller court may exceed that of larger courts.
- 3. Insofar as the proposed updated caseweights calculate a need for 232 judgeships and none are for a Cluster 1 court, I urge the Judicial Council and WAAC to continue formulating policy that recognizes smaller courts have significantly less resources than larger courts to efficiently manage the same types of operational deficiencies.
