Under Government Code section 69958, the Judicial Council is submitting the semiannual *Report of Electronic Recording Equipment Purchased or Leased by Superior Courts* for the reporting period of July 1 through December 31, 2025.

For this reporting period, two superior courts reported a combined total of \$26,251 for the purchase or lease of electronic recording equipment or related items (see Appendix A):

- Placer court: \$14,780 for use in infraction, limited civil, and misdemeanor case types.
- San Benito court: \$11,471 for use in misdemeanor case types.
