Middle French *incommoder*, from Latin *incommodare*, from *incommodus* inconvenient, from *in-* + *commodus* convenient — more at **COMMODE**

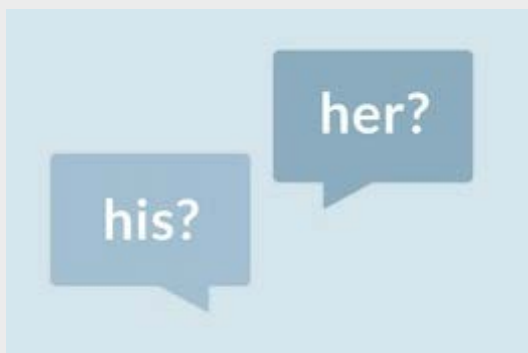
