Is it your intent that each experience cited must have included a) the deployment of a case management system, b) the deployment of a large-scale application in a judicial environment and c) the deployment of a large-scale application related to the State of California? Or it be acceptable to include experiences that only included one of those components? For example, would a large-scale deployment of an ERP system for the Commonwealth of Virginia be considered “similar in scope”?
