However, in RFP Attachment 2, Exhibit B, section 2.4 states "Construction Manager shall coordinate and oversee the independent third party commissioning services on the Project, including, without limitation the following: (2.4.3) Coordinate and oversee Judicial Council's commissioning agent's verification of system readiness" Please clarify if CMA's services are to include a commissioning entity OR will the Judicial Council retain commissioning agency services under a separate Contract Agreement for the CMA to manage / oversee?	Judicial Council will retain Commissioning Agency services under a separate agreement.

The Criteria Architect firm was awarded a contract under solicitation RFP-FS-2021-12-AL. In the RFP-FS-2021-12-AL solicitation, the preclusion language states: "Preclusion. A Firm and any sub-consultants selected as the Criteria Architect on this Project are precluded from being the architect, architect of record, or member of the Design Build Entity or its team on the Project. Successful Firm(s) will not, be precluded from consideration nor given special status in any future Judicial Council solicitations. Successful Firm(s) on a specific Project may still propose to be a consultant on a different Project." My question is: Since the preclusion language on the Criteria Architect RFP doesn't specifically state that the selected firm and their subconsultants are precluded from being a member of the Construction Management team, would our subconsultant firm be allowed to support a submitting applicant CM firm as their DVBE/cost estimating subconsultant? Or, is the Construction Management RFP preclusion implied, and thus we are also precluded from supporting any firms for this particular solicitation as well?
