Notice of Rescission of the Intent to Award dated 11/23/2020, and Issuance of a New Intent to Award

Procurement: Request for Proposal (RFP) for Facility Operation and Maintenance Services

Region: Southern

Solicitation RFP-FS-SP-2020-16-JP

Pursuant to the terms of RFP-FS-SP-2020-16-JP for Facility Operations and Maintenance Services (the "RFP"), Section 12, Administrative Requirements, Subsection L., the Judicial Council hereby rescinds the Intent to Award dated 11/23/2020 which identified UG2, LLC as the firm the Judicial Council had intended to award the contract to. The Judicial Council has determined that UG2, LCC was not currently registered with the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) as a public works contractor at the time UG2 submitted its proposal in response to the RFP, and has thus violated Labor Code §§ 1725.5 and 1771.1 and the RFP's Administrative Rules. Consequently, the Judicial Council rejects UG2, LLC's proposal to the RFP in its entirety as non-responsive.

The Judicial Council now hereby issues a new Intent to Award to the firm with the highest scoring responsive proposal.
