We ask because a profile of our entire firm's experience over the past 5 years would be extensive.</p> | <p>In 4.6 provide a profile of the firms experience and annual average revenue to include vertical transportation consulting services and other disciplines provided by the firm. Responses to 4.3, 4.4 and 4.5 should be most specific to the vertical transportation services requested in this RFP.</p> |
