- Q: Is this a full- or part-time engagement?
- A: This is a deliverable-based contract. Work could be done either full or part-time depending on the contractor's own preferences.
- Q: Does the project require an onsite presence?
- A: No, although onsite meetings could be beneficial.
- Q: Will the service provider get access to SMEs or Business stakeholders to assess/confirm the applicability of a new digital service to the existing web pages?
- A: Yes, CFCC and CJS staff will work with contractor to provide contact information for the stakeholders.
- Q: Section 2.2.5 talks about creating an alpha site. Is it same as the pilot site given in bullet point 6? Please confirm.
- A: We are hoping to have a demo of a proposed site, but it does not need to be live. Alternatively, a set of wireframes would also be acceptable.
- Q: Will the pilot site need to be exposed to a selected set of users to play around with?
- A: Yes, at a minimum JCC staff will need to have access to pilot site or be able to view wireframes.

- Q: Is it mandatory that the pilot site should be a working site? Can it be a clickable prototype instead?
- A: A clickable prototype is fine.
- Q: We assume that all the required hardware and infra will be provided for deploying the pilot site? Is our understanding correct?
- A: The site will not need to be deployed as part of this contract. The user research collected and analyzed should be used to inform the design of a new site in either the form of an alpha, clickable pilot, or wireframes.
- Q: Is the scope limited to this part of the website alone: http://www.courts.ca.gov/programs-collabjustice.htm or the whole of http://www.courts.ca.gov?
- A: This is only for the pages surrounding CA Collaborative Courts http://www.courts.ca.gov/programs-collabjustice.htm
- Q: Is project management part of the scope or will it be managed by the Project Manager from Judicial Council of California? Please confirm.
- A: JCC staff will work with the contractor on project management, but the contractor will need to be responsible for meeting deliverables and their own staff.
- Q: The RFP talks about wire-frames/alpha site/working pilot site as one of the final deliverables need more clarity here because these are different things. Request to share more details on these deliverables.
- A: We are hoping to have a demo of a proposed site, but it does not need to be live.

 Alternatively, a set of wireframes would also be acceptable for this deliverable. We leave the specifics up to the discretion of the contractor.
