Note: Unless a rare exception is granted by the Judicial Council, consultants for each category will work within the continental United States.

* All hourly rates shall remain firm fixed for the full duration of the Initial Term. If the Judicial Council elects to exercise an option term, and the Contractor makes a written request for an adjustment to the hourly rates before the

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option term is exercised, and the Judicial Council agrees to the adjustment, hourly rates may not increase by more than the lesser of 3% or the average percentage change in the Employment Cost Index for total compensation, for private industry workers, by occupational group and industry, service-providing industries, over the prior twelve (12) month period. If Contractor does not request an increase before the extension option is exercised, the then-current rates may remain in effect for the option year. Any adjustment shall not be retroactive to a prior year. Except for such rate increases, rates shall remain firm fixed for the duration of the option term. Resource time may be billed at a rate lower than published per agreement if appropriate for the specific resource but must not exceed the fixed hourly rate. Billing must be for actual time worked, to the nearest quarter (.25) hour. For example, if a consultant works for 1 hour 15 minutes, billing should be for no more than 1.25 hours. If a consultant works for 1 hour 25 minutes, billing should be for no more than 1.5 hours.
