2	On page 2 of the RFP, the Judicial Council's RFP indicates you are seeking "...proposals from firms to provide the services of qualified, properly licensed consultants [emphasis added]...". Can you clarify what license you are referring to?	RFP, Page 2, Section 2.1	<p>Please refer to RFP section 3.1 (<i>Licensing</i>) which provides:</p> <p>"All Consultants, and their sub-consultant(s), employees, or agents thereof, performing work on Projects awarded under this RFP must have, when submitting a Proposal as well as at the commencement of and all times throughout the duration of their performance of any work, all appropriate, valid license(s) required under law to provide the work being performed. <u>If the possession of any license(s) including, without limitation, a valid California real estate license, is required under law for the performance of the work</u>, the Consultant must ensure that the work will be performed either by an appropriately licensed individual or under the direct supervision of an appropriately licensed individual."
